

CPV Program Admission Requirements

- Must be a United States citizen
- Must have a valid Texas Driver's License or Texas ID
- Must have current automobile insurance (if driving patrol vehicle)
- Must not have received excessive traffic citations in the last three years
- Must be at least 18 years of age
- Must live, work or be a student in the City of Denton (those individuals outside of Denton will be viewed on a case by case basis)
- Must successfully undergo a Texas Crime Information Center (TCIC) background check, including fingerprint submission to the FBI
- Must successfully complete an interview with the Denton Police Community Resource Officer

The CPV Program

Citizen Police Volunteers are trained and organized volunteers who operate under the control of the Denton Police Department Community Resource Officer (CRO). Volunteers are not police officers, but they are an extra set of “eyes & ears” and are a valued resource to the police department.



CPV Program Mission

The mission of the Denton Citizen Police Volunteer Program is to assist the City of Denton Police Department in reducing and deterring crime while improving the individual and collective safety and general welfare of all people of the City of Denton.

Required Conduct

Citizen Police Volunteers will behave in a professional manner at all times and are to exercise common sense and good judgment while participating in the program. Volunteers will be responsible for their own acts and they shall not shift this burden to others.

Volunteers are required to be familiar with and adhere to all rules, regulations and policies of the Denton Police Department, the City of Denton and the Citizen Police Volunteer Program.

Responsibilities

Include, but are not limited to:

- Proper execution of assigned duties
- Maintenance of proper community relations
- Maintenance of discipline
- Reporting through the chain of command any development that may affect the Department and its operations, or general public
- Proper care, control, and use of any departmental resources, equipment, materials or supplies
- Regard all information learned as part of Citizen Police Volunteer Program activities as confidential

Required Training

Training is provided by the Denton Police Department, including an overview of department policy, goals, procedures, specific rules and regulations for each area, as well as skills training and testing as necessary. Updates and/or refresher training will be provided by the Police Department or its designees.

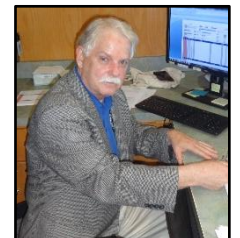
