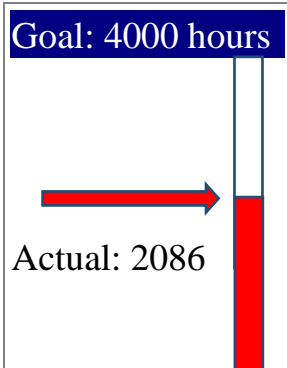

Susie Mikler was also a finalist for the Volunteer of the Year award. Susie helped our PD write and submit a federal grant for \$494,225 to the Department of Justice for the Sexual Assault Kit Initiative (SAKI) grant program. The goal of this program is to address the growing number of unsubmitted SAKs in law enforcement custody, and to help provide resolution for victims when possible. The expected outcomes include enhanced storage facilities, tracking system, identification and reduction of barriers that may result in backlog, improved technical skills, and accountability. 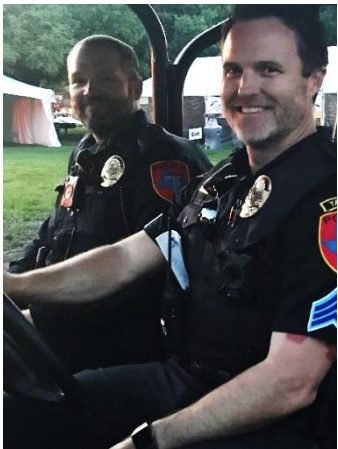
