We also sold our CPAAA merchandise and gave away Denton PD/911 helpful information to the community.

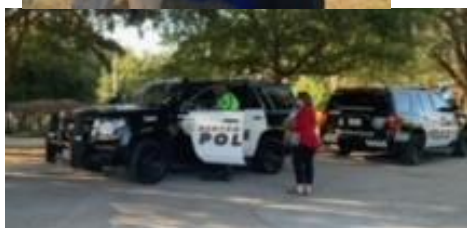


**Arts & Autos** took place on Saturday, September 11<sup>th</sup>.
